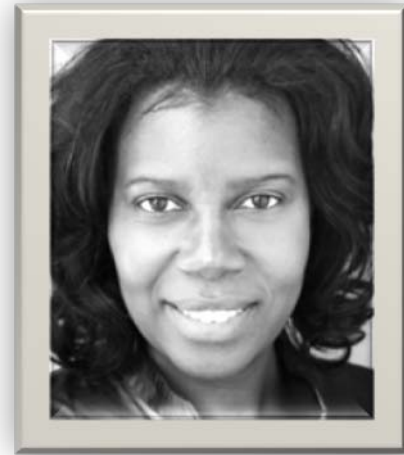

DRESS CODE

Except as required for the runway part of the camp, campers do not need a special wardrobe to attend our camp. They should, however, stay up to date with current fashions and trends

The items listed below are what Showbiz deems appropriate for attending camps, workshops and auditions:

Girls 13 and up

- Dresses, skirts Short underneath
- Slacks, khakis
- Nice jeans
- Blouses, dress tops, no midriiffs showing
- Sweaters

Boys 13 and up

- Slacks or khakis
- Nice jeans
- Dress shirts
- Loafers, dress shoes, nice clean sneakers
- Sweaters, cardigans, nice short sleeve top

Children 5 to 12

- Bright colors
- Denim tops
- Fashion tops
- Sweaters
- Button down shirts
- Clean sneakers
- khakis



CAMP RULES

- Parents must arrive and drop off kids in the lobby of the SHOWBIZ Studios. They must also arrive promptly at 4:45pm for pick up.
- At no time should parents be in the classroom during regularly scheduled camp times unless the instructor requires the parents to be there.
- Students should have proper classroom behavior as is required in all educational settings. There should be no chewing gum, leaving the classroom without permission, or disruptive behavior. Students who disrupt the classroom will be given a warning and send to the camp director. If the disruptive behavior continues for more than one class, parents will be informed and the student will be removed from the class without refund.
- Food and drink are NOT permitted in the studios or classrooms, except for lunch. Students must remove all litter and other materials they brought to the classroom and dispose of it in the allocated trash bins. They must make sure their surroundings are clean and neat before they leave the camp.
- Lunch will not be provided and must be brought everyday to camp. We will provide two light snacks per day for the campers.
- If students arrive early or need to wait after class, they must stay in the reception area at all times.
- **Parents or caretakers MUST arrive within 15 minutes after the class ends to pick up the campers. If campers are not picked up within 15 minutes of the end camp, a charge of \$20 per quarter hour will be charged. If students are not picked up within two hours of the end of camp, and if all attempts to locate a parent, guardian or other designated person are unsuccessful, Showbiz reserves the right to call upon the proper authorities.**
- Showbiz Kids and teens is not responsible for any personal property campers bring to the studio.
- Please note changes may be made to daily activities
- Field Trips are optional and will require an additional fee
